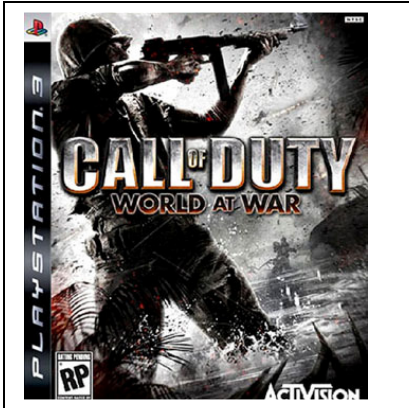


# In the Box With Jack Bowen

*Game: Call of Duty 5*
